Reverend Paul Moore, 74, of Denton, TX, Formerly of Amite County, MS was called upon for the next leg of his journey to a place prepared for him by our Lord and Savior on Saturday, November 16, 2024, at University Rehabilitation Center, in Denton, TX.

Rev. Paul Moore was born in Amite County, MS on December 21, 1950, to Burnice and the late Enos Moore.

Rev. Moore graduated from Central High School in Liberty, MS, Class of 1968. Upon graduating, he joined the Job Corp. He was later drafted by the US Army and served in Viet Nam. He was honorably discharged. Rev. Moore received his BS Degree in Theology from Dallas Christian College. For more than 25 years, he worked for Hayes Albion in Tiffin, Ohio, and Air Products in North Baltimore, Ohio, where he retired. Before his health began to decline, he was employed by University Behavioral Health, in Denton, TX.

Rev. Moore was baptized and accepted the Lord Jesus Christ at a very young age at Star Hill CME Church, Gloster, MS. He was a loving son, brother,

father, grandfather and great grandfather who always put others before himself. He touched the lives of so many people with his kindness, compassion and generosity. He was dearly loved and will be sadly missed by all. Rev. Paul Moore was ordained as a minister on November 15, 1998, at Bethel Baptist Church, in Fostoria, Ohio, where he was an Associate Pastor and later became the Pastor for two years. After moving to Denton, TX, in 2004, he joined Morse Street Baptist Church where he served as an Associate Minister. He devoted most of his pastoral time to Nursing Home Ministry at Cottonwood Nursing and Rehabilitation.

Rev. Moore was preceded in death by his father, Enos Moore, and a brother, Jerry Neal Moore.
